


The Joys of Gelli Printing with Maureen Lipa 9am - 4pm

Throw a Pot - Start to Finish in a Day! with Narelle Fullwood 9am - 4pm



Receive guidance on how to simplify plant form and create a harmonious composition. Learn how different mediums can enhance a collagraph and how to prepare your matrix for printing.

We will be printing with CAGs new professional etching press onto watercolour paper and using coloured oil-based printing inks. Learn how to ink up a collagraph in different ways so that each print is unique.
