LASK

Illness and Accident Policy

Please inform us if your child has been ill within the last 24 hours before contracted period. LASK do not undertake the care of sick children, and we must think of the other children in our care.

Parents should inform LASK of symptoms of ill health shown by your child. If your child has sickness and/or Diarrhoea, you must keep them home for 24 hours.

If your child becomes ill whilst in the care of LASK we will contact you, and according to the severity of the illness, may ask you to take your child home.

Children who are unwell with an infectious disease should not be at the club; once they are better they can return to the club unless they pose a risk of infection to others. They should not return until the risk has passed.

If your child has an accident in the club we will complete an accident form and ask you to sign it. If there are any major accidents within the club involving your child, we will call an ambulance if required and we will call you ASAP.

If your child has any existing injuries which have happened outside of the club, we will ask you to complete an existing injuries form.
