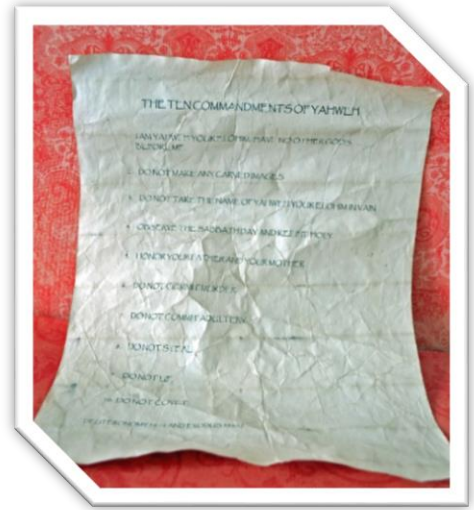


Ancient Ten Commandments Scroll

This is a fun craft that will show you how to make your paper scroll look like it came from long ago!

Supplies Needed:

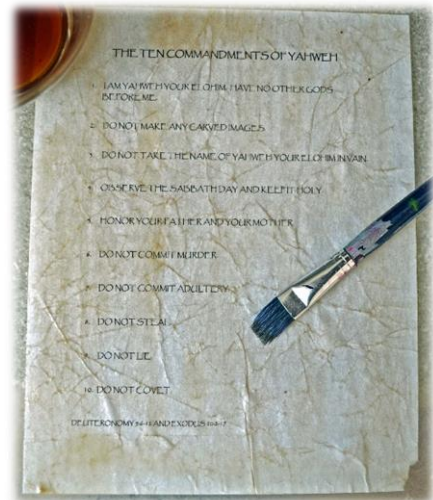
- Sheet of paper – standard white printer paper
- Coffee (already prepared) or tea (3 teabags in a cup of hot water)
- Bowl to hold coffee or tea liquid
- Thick paintbrush or paper towel rolled in a ball
- String or ribbon – about 18" long



And Shaphan the scribe told the king, saying, Hilkiah the priest has given a book to me; and Shaphan read it before the king. 2 Kings 22:10

Instructions:

1. Write the 10 Commandments on your piece of paper. Or use the pre-typed page included.
2. Crumple it up – this will give it texture when it soaks up the tea or coffee. Then flatten it out.
3. With your paintbrush or paper towel, dip it into the coffee or tea and brush your entire paper on both sides until it is completely covered. You can make it as dark or light as you desire. Gently tear the edges to make it look even more authentic.
4. Lay out your wet paper on a rack or place some medium-size rocks underneath the paper to dry it out. You can dry it outside in the sun for quick drying.
5. Once your paper is dry, starting at the top of your paper, carefully roll your paper into a scroll.
6. Tie your scroll together with the string or ribbon.
