DOCKETING ORDER FOR THE MONTHS OF MARCH AND APRIL 2021

There being an Order from the Tennessee Supreme Court limiting all in-person court proceedings at this time due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Juvenile Court of Campbell County, Tennessee, hereby ORDERS as follows:

CASES WHICH CAN BE RESCHEDULED

1. If your child's case in Campbell County Juvenile Court is set for any day in March or April 2021, and the only charge your child has is a **Tobacco or Vaping charge** with no other charges pending, please contact the Clerk's office immediately at (423) 562-2624 for a rescheduling of your court date to a future date after the pandemic has passed, rather than appearing in court during these months.

2. If your child's case in Campbell County Juvenile Court is set for any in March or April 2021, and the only charges your child has are for **Traffic violations** (such as speeding, no insurance, using a cell phone while driving) and did not involve an allegation of underage driving while impaired, anything drug or alcohol-related, or a crash, then please contact the Clerk's office immediately at (423) 562-2624 for a rescheduling of your court date to a future date after the pandemic has passed, rather than appearing in court during these months.

**CASES WHICH CANNOT BE (OR HAVE NOT ALREADY BEEN)
RESCHEDULED SHALL BE ON A TIME DOCKET**

3. All other cases on the Campbell County Juvenile docket which are set for any day in March or April 2021, and are not otherwise reset by agreement of the parties by order or through the Clerk are hereby amended to begin at the following times, instead of the time it was originally set:

(a) If the *oldest* child on the case's *last name* begins with the letter A through E, that case is now set at 9:00 a.m. on the same day as the case was previously set. (If the oldest child on the case's last name is hyphenated, then the first portion of the last name prevails.)

(b) If the oldest child on the case's last name begins with the letter F through J, that case is now set at 10:00 a.m. on the same day as the case was previously set.

(c) If the oldest child on the case's last name begins with the letter K through M, that case is now set at 11:00 a.m. on the same day as the case was previously set.


(d) If the oldest child on the case's last name begins with the letter N through S, that case is now set at 1:00 p.m. on the same day as the case was previously set.

(e) If the oldest child on the case's last name begins with the letter T through W, that case is now set at 2:00 p.m. on the same day as the case was previously set.

(f) If the oldest child on the case's last name begins with the letter X through Z, that case is now set at 3:00 p.m. on the same day as the case was previously set.

5. All persons appearing in Court on any day in March or April 2021, (whether attorneys, plaintiffs, defendants, victims, witnesses, non-parties, DCS workers or court services providers) shall read and abide by this Court's Order of Procedure for these months, taking measures to appear in Court electronically rather than in-person during these months, wherever possible.
